

Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver e-mod

The Traumatic Brain Injury Waiver [TBI] is a program of the **New York State Department of Health**

Eligibility:

- Household must be a participant in the Department of Health Traumatic Brain Injury Medicaid Waiver Program –which provides home based health services for Medicaid eligible individuals with a diagnosed traumatic brain injury.

How to apply for assistance:

- Households should work with their TBI Service Coordinator &/or Regional Resource Development Center [RRDC] for application.
- There is no waitlist for this program.
- Households must obtain 3 bids for work over \$1,000.
- All costs must be prior approved by the RRDC for the TBI Waiver Program.

Modifications not covered by this program:

All adaptations must be medically necessary. Modifications that do not promote independence in home or community will not be approved (i.e carpets, roof repair).

Maximum assistance levels:

\$15,000 per eligible unit. Households may also combine non-waiver environmental modification programs to meet their need.
